Hong Kong, 22 May 2019 - The Hong Kong Aviation Club is deeply saddened by the recent loss of one of our members, Andrew Wong Fai-hung, and we are sorry to have lost a passionate aviator and loving husband and father.

At approximately 4:40 pm on 19 May, Andrew took off from Shek Kong Airfield in a helicopter by himself with no passengers. We were later informed that the helicopter had crashed near the Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden at approximately 5:30 pm and that Andrew had lost his life in connection with the accident.

Our thoughts are with the family, friends and loved ones affected by the accident.

The Hong Kong Aviation Club is committed to safety, and accordingly, we are working with the authorities to determine the cause of the accident. In the meantime, until the cause of the accident is clearer, we have temporarily suspended all flying operations.
