HONG KONG(31 May, 2019) – Following the temporary suspension of all flying operations after the helicopter accident on 19 May 2019, the Hong Kong Aviation Club (HKAC) launched an intensive Safety Assessment to identify possible safety concerns on our fleet.

Having implemented additional safety checks and mitigation measures in our engineering and flight operations, we are now ready to resume limited fixed-wing operation on the 1 June 2019.
